TUESDAY AFTERNOON LEAGUE 2022-2023

- The Tuesday Afternoon League will begin Sept. 6, 2022 at 12:30 p.m. We will bowl for 32 weeks 15 weeks each half with a fun night each half, a 9-pin and 9-pin blind doubles. We will not have position matches.
- Teams will consist of 4 regular bowlers. A minimum of 2 regular bowlers must be present at the start of bowling or the games must be forfeited. A bowler must show up before the last person of the 4th frame to be able to bowl that game.
- 3. A team may choose to have a 5th or 6th member to be a regular bowler to use as a backup bowler or on a rotating schedule.
- 4. Three games will be bowled in each session. A 7-point system will be used. Two points per game and one point for total pins. Roll-off determined by total pins with handicap.
- 5. A bowler may be permitted to finish the final game of the series before her teammates and opponents if needed.
- 6. Handicap figures at 90% of the difference between an individual's average and the scratch average of 170. Three games are required to establish an individual's average. First day of competition, handicaps will be based on the average established after 3 games, thereafter it will be based on current games bowled in this league.
- 7. Vacancy Score No permanent bowler 120 pins with 40 pins handicap. Vacancy scores may only be used for a maximum of two weeks.
- Absent Score Regular bowler is unable to attend Member's current average minus 10 pins plus established handicap.
- Sponsor Fee -- \$25 Bowling Fee -- \$13 of which \$10 per bowler will be paid to the lanes. Captains of each team are responsible for collecting money each week. Teams owing overdue money will forfeit games until balance is paid.
- 10. The President and Treasurer shall be paid the following: President \$25, Treasurer \$50. President has waived her fee for the 2022-2023 season.
- 11. If there is a blind team, the "Blind" team will need to beat the scores of the team to their right when they are alone.
- 12. Officers shall determine what is sufficient cause to grant postponement of games between 2 teams. Other than a sudden emergency, teams must contact secretary 48 hours before normal bowling time to reschedule. Officers will decide on postponement due to bad weather.
- 13. Prebowling will be allowed and a date must be stated on the prebowl scores and they must be used. If unable to bowl due to Covid-19, a bowler has 14 days to make the games up.

- 14. In the event of a tie for 1st place in a half, all teams involved with advance to roll off with total pins determining the winner. If this also results in a tie, an extra frame plus 1/10th of handicap shall determine the winner.
- 15. Individual and team prize money will be based on a full season. A bowler must have bowled a minimum of 1/2 the season to be eligible for prize money. The League Champions may choose a trophy for their sponsor or individual cash prizes for each bowler. Subs are eligible for prize money if bowling more than one half season.
- 16. No new subs may be brought in the last 3 weeks of each ½ of bowling unless it is an emergency. This must be approved by the League Officers.
- 17. If a team must use a sub or a bowler from a team not in the roll-off during the roll-off, they must have an average of 10 pins above or below the average of the person they are bowling for.
- 18. If for some reason a bowler cannot finish the seasons, they must give a two-week notice to the league or pay the cost for the next two weeks.
- 19. Each team will receive funds for 4 people from the League to use for the End-Of-Season banquet.
- 20. Decorating committee will receive \$30 to be used for banquet decorations.
- 21. Instead of a gift exchange for Christmas a donation to a charity will be collected.
