****NEW BOWLERS** – use average of 21 games. Please have league secretary verify average on separate form and attach to entry. If you have not bowled 21 games prior to sending in entry, have league secretary verify average before you bowl. If you do not have an average at time of bowling, highest average in last five years will be used.

Tournament Rules

1. The Tri Cities USBC Association will promote, conduct either by direct or under its direction and auspices an annual tournament for the Tri Cities Men.
2. All tournament rules to be set up at organizational meeting.
3. All entries into tournament must be members of the association.
4. No changes shall be made in the schedule unless a member can give adequate reason for inability to roll his game.
5. Teams and individuals must be ready to bowl at least 30 minutes before scheduled time.
6. Notifications will be sent out, for those who pre-registered, one week before the tournament.
7. The first team, doubles, and singles event bowled will be used for all events – USBC rule 315d.
8. Bowlers may bowl more than once in team event (must change two bowlers – USBC rule 315b)
9. Doubles and singles may be bowled more than once, you must change partners for doubles – USBC rule 315b. Single bowlers may not place more than once – USBC rule 315c.
10. 10 pin rule is in effect – USBC 319-2.
11. USBC rule 319-3 is incorrect average reporting will warrant disqualification.
12. There will be no one allowed on the lanes except tournament bowlers while bowling is going on. Open bowling is allowed with a lane between bowlers on open lanes.
